Beginning Stained Glass

Class Syllabus

Purpose: To learn the basic elements of creating a stained glass piece using the copper foil method and the lead came method. Required course for "experienced" class.

Objectives:

- To practice cutting glass
- To practice tight fitting
- To practice glass assembly
- To practice application of copper foil to glass
- To practice assembling a stained glass piece using lead came
- To solder two glass pieces

Date and Time:
