Experienced Stained Glass

Class Syllabus

Purpose: To practice the elements of creating a stained glass piece using the copper foil method or the lead came method. The piece is approximately 10" X 10" Must have completed 'Beginning' stained glass course and have equipment to work on pieces between class sessions.

Objectives:

- To cut and fit glass for medium sized flat glass piece suitable for a window
- To practice tight fitting
- To practice assembling medium sized glass piece
- To practice application of copper foil or lead came to glass piece
- To solder the medium sized glass piece

- Thursday, January 28, February 4 & 11, 2010; 5:30 pm - 9:00 pm

Cost:

Supplies Provided:

- scrap glass for pieces, patterns and design equipment
- copper foil or lead came
- solder

Supplies Student Provides:

- cork backed 12" to 15" ruler (Staples)
- glass cutter
- glass table top grinder (available from Gilded Glass)
- breaking and grozing pliers (available from Gilded Glass)
- horse shoe nails
- fid or lathekin
- apron
- hammer
- band-aides

Amenities
